A resolution has been prepared to accept the proposal submitted by Vogel Traffic Services for paint striping streets within city limits. Estimated cost for the service is \$7,455.00.

The contract with Vogel Traffic Services is administered through the Sarpy County Highway Department. Each city in Sarpy County is billed separately for the number of gallons applied. The City of La Vista has been participating in this program for more than 12 years. A city employee accompanies Vogel Traffic Services during the entire painting process.
