

# ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES



## **Permit Issuance**

For the issuance of each electrical permit:

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| Permit issuance   | <b>\$30.00</b> |
| For the issuance of each supplemental permit for which the original permit has not expired, been canceled, or finalized | <b>\$8.00</b>  |

## **System Fee Schedule**

Please note that the following do not include the permit issuance fee:

**New Residential Buildings:** The following Fees shall include all wiring and electrical equipment in or on each building, or other electrical equipment on the same premises constructed at the same time:

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| <b>Multi-Family:</b> For new multi-family buildings (apartments and condominiums) having three or more dwelling units constructed at the same time, not including the area of garages, carports, and accessory buildings, per square foot (0.09 m <sup>2</sup> ) | <b>\$0.08/sq. ft.</b>  |
| <b>Single and Two-Family:</b> For new single and two-family residential buildings constructed at the same time and not including the area of garages carports and accessory buildings, per square foot (0.09 m <sup>2</sup> )                                    | <b>\$0.086/sq. ft.</b> |

## **Private Swimming Pools:**

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| For new private, in-ground swimming pools for single-family and multi-family occupancies, including a complete system of necessary branch circuit wiring, bonding, grounding, underwater lighting, water pumping, and other similar electrical equipment directly related to the operation of a swimming pool, each pool | <b>\$49.50</b> |
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**Carnivals and Circuses:** Carnivals, circuses, or other traveling shows or exhibitions utilizing transportable-type rides, booths, displays, and attractions.

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| For electrical generators and electrically driven rides   | <b>\$25 each</b>   |
| For mechanically driven rides and walk-through attractions or displays having electric lighting | <b>\$8.00 each</b> |
| For a system of area and booth lighting   | <b>\$8.00 each</b> |
| For permanently installed rides, booths, displays and attractions use the "Unit Fee Schedule"   | <b>N/A</b>         |

## Temporary Power Service

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| For a temporary service pole or pedestal, including all pole or pedestal-mounted receptacle outlets and appurtenances   | <b>\$27.00 each</b> |
| For a temporary distribution system and temporary lighting and receptacle outlets for construction sites, decorative lights, Christmas tree sales lots, fireworks stand, etc. | <b>\$14.15 each</b> |

## Unit Fee Schedule

Please note that the following do not include the permit issuance fee:

**Receptacle, Switch and Light Outlets:** For receptacle, switch, light, or other outlets at which current is used or controlled, except services, feeders and meters. Please note that for multi-outlet assemblies, each five (5) feet (1524 mm) or fraction thereof may be considered as one outlet.

**Lighting Fixtures:** For lighting fixtures, sockets, or other lamp-holding devices:

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| First 20 fixtures                                   | <b>\$1.25 each</b> |

| For pole or platform-mounted lighting fixtures      | <b>\$1.25 each</b> |
| For theatrical-type lighting fixtures or assemblies | <b>\$1.25 each</b> |

## Residential Appliances

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| For fixed residential or receptacle outlets for same, including wall-mounted electric ovens, counter-mounted cooking tops, electric ranges, self-contained room, console, or through-wall air conditioners, space heaters, food waste grinders, dishwashers, washing machines, water heaters, clothes dryers or other motor-operated appliances not exceeding one (1) horsepower (HP) (746 W) in rating. For other types of air conditioners and other motor-driver appliances having larger electrical ratings, see Power Apparatus. | <b>\$5.45 each</b> |
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## Non-Residential Appliances

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| For non-residential appliances and self-contained factory-wired, non-residential appliances not exceeding one (1) horsepower (HP), kilowatt (kW) or kilovolt-ampere (kVA), in rating, including medical and dental devices, food, beverage and ice cream cabinets, illuminated show cases, drinking fountains, vending machines, laundry machines or other similar types of equipment. For other types of air conditioners and other motor-driven appliances having larger electrical ratings, see Power Apparatus. | <b>\$5.45 each</b> |
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**Power Apparatus:** For motors, generators, transformers, rectifiers, synchronous converters, capacitors, industrial heating, air conditioners, heat pumps, cooking or baking equipment and other apparatus as follows: Rating in horsepower (HP), kilowatts (kW), kilovolt-amperes (kVA) or kilovolt-amperes-reactive (kVAR). For equipment or appliances having more than one motor, transformer, heater, etc. the sum of the combined ratings may be used. These fees include all switches, circuit breakers, contractors, thermostats, relays and other directly related control equipment.

### Bus-ways

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| For trolley and plug-in-type bus-ways, each one hundred (100) feet (30.48 mm) or fraction thereof. An additional fee is required for lighting fixtures, motors and other appliances that are connected to trolley and plug-in-type bus-ways. A fee is not required for portable tools. | <b>\$8.00</b> |
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### Signs, Outline Lighting & Marquees

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| For signs, outline lighting systems or marquees supplied from one branch circuit        | <b>\$28.30 each</b> |
| For additional branch circuits within the same sign, outline lighting system or marquee | <b>\$5.45each</b>   |

### Service

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| For services of 600 volts or less and not over 200 amperes in rating | <b>\$35.05 each</b>  |
| For services of 600 volts or less and between 200 and 1,000 amperes  | <b>\$71.45 each</b>  |
| For services over 600 volts, or over 1,000 amperes in rating         | <b>\$142.92 each</b> |

**Miscellaneous Apparatus, Conduits & Conductors:** This fee is not applicable when a fee is paid for one or more services, outlets, fixtures, appliances, power apparatus, bus-ways, signs or other equipment.

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| For electrical apparatus, conduits and conductors for which a permit is required, but for which no fee is herein set forth | <b>\$20.95</b> |
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### Other Inspection Fees

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| Inspections outside of normal business hours (min. charge – 2 hrs)   | <b>\$52.00/hr</b>    |
| Re-Inspection fees assessed under provisions of Section 305.8  | <b>\$52.00/insp.</b> |
| Inspections for which no fee is indicated (min. charge – ½ hr)   | <b>\$52.00/hr</b>    |
| Additional plan review required by changes, additions, or revisions to plans or to plans for which an initial review has been completed (min. charge – ½ hr) | <b>\$52.00/hr</b>    |
