**Please sign in on the registration sheet when you arrive. If children are accompanying you, please keep them with you at all times.**

**Please bring the following with you when you come:**

- current year's tax forms and preparation booklet
- copy of last year's income tax return(s)
- W-2 forms from each employer
- unemployment compensation statements (if applicable)
- SSA-1099 form if you were paid Social Security benefits
- all 1099 forms (1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B, etc.) showing interest and/or dividends and documentation showing original purchase price of sold assets
- 1099-misc. showing any miscellaneous income
- 1099-R form if you received a pension or annuity
- all forms indicating federal income tax paid
- dependent care provider information (name, employer, ID, Social Security No.)
- all receipts or canceled checks if itemizing deductions
- Social Security numbers for all dependents

**Health Insurance:**

- form 1095A if you purchased health insurance through the Marketplace (Exchange).
- any exemption correspondence from the Marketplace (if applicable).
