A meeting of the City Council of the City of La Vista, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 6:00 p.m. on September 20, 2022. Also in attendance were, City Attorney McKeon, City Clerk Buethe, Chief of Police Lausten, Director of Public Works Soucie, Library Director Barcal, Recreation Director Stopak, Deputy Community Development Director Solberg and City Engineer Dowse.

2. ORDINANCE – APPROVE AMENDED BUDGET

Councilmember Quick introduced Ordinance No. 1459: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1423 AND THE BIENNIAL BUDGET APPROPRIATING THE SUMS OF MONEY DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL OF THE NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF LA VISTA, SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; AND FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, AND SPECIFICALLY TO AMEND AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED FOR THE SECOND YEAR OF SUCH BIENNIAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SUCH APPROPRIATIONS ARE MADE AND THE AMOUNT TO BE APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OBJECT OR PURPOSE; SPECIFYING THE AMOUNT TO BE RAISED BY TAX LEVY; PROVIDING FOR THE FILING AND CERTIFICATION OF THE BUDGET AND TAX LEVY HEREIN SENT TO THE STATE AUDITOR AND COUNTY CLERK OF SARPY COUNTY; TO REPEAL INCONSISTENT OR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS AS ORIGINALLY ENACTED; AND PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

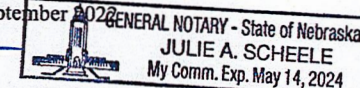

SYNOPSIS

A public hearing has been scheduled and a resolution prepared to establish the property tax request for FY23.

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed tax levy would be \$0.54 cents per \$100 of assessed property valuation. Specifically:

General Fund — \$0.50 per \$100 of assessed property valuation
Bond Fund — \$0.04 per \$100 of assessed property valuation

RECOMMENDATION

Approval.

BACKGROUND

A public hearing on the proposed budget was held August 2, 2022. At the City Council meeting on August 16, 2022, Council directed staff to prepare the notice of budget statement based upon a municipal levy of \$0.54 cents per \$100 of valuation. The General Fund levy of \$0.50 cents represents a 1% increase over the prior year General Fund levy of \$0.49 cents. The Debt Service Fund levy of \$0.04 cents represents a 20% decrease over the prior year Debt Service Fund levy of \$0.05 cents.

In FY23, the owner of a home with a County assessed value of \$167,000 will pay \$902 in property taxes or \$75.15 per month at a zero change over the prior fiscal year.

The County Assessor has notified the City that the tax year 2022 taxable value in La Vista is \$2,220,556,943 with new growth of \$24,572,696.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VISTA, NEBRASKA
SETTING THE CITY'S PROPERTY TAX REQUEST FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023.

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1633(4) provides that the Governing Body of the City of La Vista passes by a majority vote a resolution setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, Public hearings were held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the City of La Vista, resolves that:

1. The 2022 – 2023 property tax request be set at \$11,991,007.00.
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 11%.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$.485892 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. The City of La Vista proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$.54 per \$100 of assessed value; and
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the City of La Vista will exceed last year's by 21%.
6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the Sarpy County Clerk on or before October 15, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City council of the City of La Vista Nebraska that the property tax to be distributed as follows:

General Fund - \$11,102,784.00 (\$0.50 mill levy)

Bond Fund - \$888,223.00 (\$0.04 mill levy)

A copy of this resolution and other required documents be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk in accordance with applicable law.

SYNOPSIS

A resolution has been prepared to approve a professional services agreement with METALAB for Phase II services, which includes design refinement, integration and cost estimation for the iconic feature over the 84th Street Underpass in an amount not to exceed \$32,600.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FY23/FY24 biennial budget provides funding for multiple potential public infrastructure improvements and associated services.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On October 19, 2021 the City Council approved an agreement with Metalab to provide conceptual design services associated with an iconic element over the 84th Street Underpass. With the design of the underpass underway and understanding that the iconic feature will likely have an impact on the underpass structure, it was determined that preliminary design work related to the iconic feature should be conducted in conjunction with the work on the underpass. The two structures will be constructed in very close proximity and coordination of design work is essential.

Conceptual design work on the iconic structure has been completed and Metalab has provided a proposal for Phase II services, which include design refinement, integration, and cost estimation. With the conceptual design in hand Metalab will work with structural engineers and potential fabricators to discover any potential issues and work through any necessary adjustments to the design.

Also, the Phase II scope provides for Metalab to work with the design consultants (Design Workshop/Schemmer) for the streetscape/underpass project to refine how the iconic feature will integrate into the designs for that project. This will provide Design Workshop/Schemmer with the information necessary to finalize the design for the streetscape/underpass in order to meet the deadlines of the federal grant process.

As deliverables, the City will receive updated refined renderings and a cost estimate for the iconic feature.


